High school students began work Thursday on beautifying the Fresno Metropolitan Flood Control District's Trolley Creek Park in southeast Fresno.

The students came from schools around Fresno through the Younger Youth Program, which is run by the Fresno County Economic Opportunities Commission and funded by the Fresno County Workforce Investment Board.

The work is among activities chosen by program staffers to help develop leadership skills.

The students removed graffiti, planted flowers, replaced sand under swing sets and painted picnic pavilions, water fountains, fencing and a building reproduction of the Meux Home at the three-acre park, which has a Fresno history theme.
