#### About Central Valley Against Human Trafficking (CVAHT)

Central Valley Against Human Trafficking was founded in 2009 as a result of staff's increased awareness of minor girls presenting at Sanctuary Youth Shelter with a history of trafficking.

Collaboration became a keystone of our work and the Central Valley Freedom Coalition, a network of agencies and concerned citizens dedicated to partnership was formed. The project now serves victims and survivors of all forms of human trafficking regardless of age, gender or immigration status throughout a six county region. Since 2010 CVAHT has identified and connected over 550 victims of trafficking originating from 21 different countries to comprehensive empowerment-based services to support recovery and healing. Additionally, CVAHT provides training and technical assistance to multi-sector professionals and outreach to those most vulnerable or at-risk.
