As an agency, we are working closely with our staff to follow guidelines and make adjustments to our procedures as necessary.

Fresno EOC Transit Systems, as an essential public service, will continue to operate unless contracting agencies direct otherwise.

Fresno EOC Transit Systems has developed an individual plan and strategy to maintain a connection with clients and partners while staying safe. These measures include:

- Working to ensure a safe environment by following the health standards set by the California Department of Public Health and the Fresno County Department of Public Health through the sanitation of our facilities and vehicles and the cleanliness practices amongst our employees.
- Increasing the frequency of cleaning regimens for all vehicles designed to disinfect high touch areas including all railings, seating, arm rests, seat belts, door handles, fare boxes, and operator areas. Each vehicle is disinfected multiple times during each route.
- Providing gloves to all drivers to wear while operating their routes in addition to supplying disinfectant wipes, sprays, and hand sanitizers.
- Encouraging riders to practice social distancing and leave space between themselves, other passengers, and the operator.
- Adjusting employee schedules based on customer and client needs.

We are committed to serving our community and are adjusting as we can to continue the necessary services in these unprecedented times.
