Fresno EOC Transit Systems has been selected by Fresno State for the second consecutive year to be the sole shuttle service provider at Bulldog football games. That means fans ride free! Transit Systems will transport people who attend home football games to and from the parking lots and the stadium.

Transit Systems has provided shuttle services at home games for people with disabilities since 2018 with two buses. We now have eight buses assigned to the regular parking areas and two buses assigned to parking areas that are accessible to people with disabilities. The next home game will take place on **October 29** against San Diego State. **Go Dogs!**

Communication is Key




Fresno EOC Transit Systems drivers received training to provide quality service for passengers who are deaf or hearing impaired. At an in-service on August 27, the Deaf and Hard of Hearing Service Center (DHHSC), headquartered in Fresno, provided a presentation to **67** drivers. Educational Services Director, Susan Coulter, gave our drivers a unique perspective on the challenges that individuals who are deaf or hard of hearing go through, such as the struggles to communicate or any immediate issues they are having with the service or trip.

Not only did Coulter provide information and resources to help our drivers with their jobs, but also their personal lives. For example, opening the door to services for people who have family members who need them and helping our drivers identify hearing issues with family members.

Transit Systems is developing a network with DHHSC to improve services for our passengers, and looking for useful ways to communicate trip information by phone or with easy-to-use pictographs.


