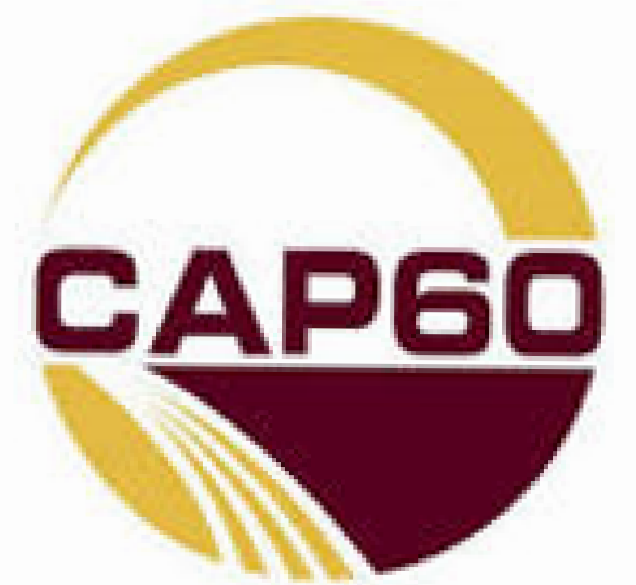

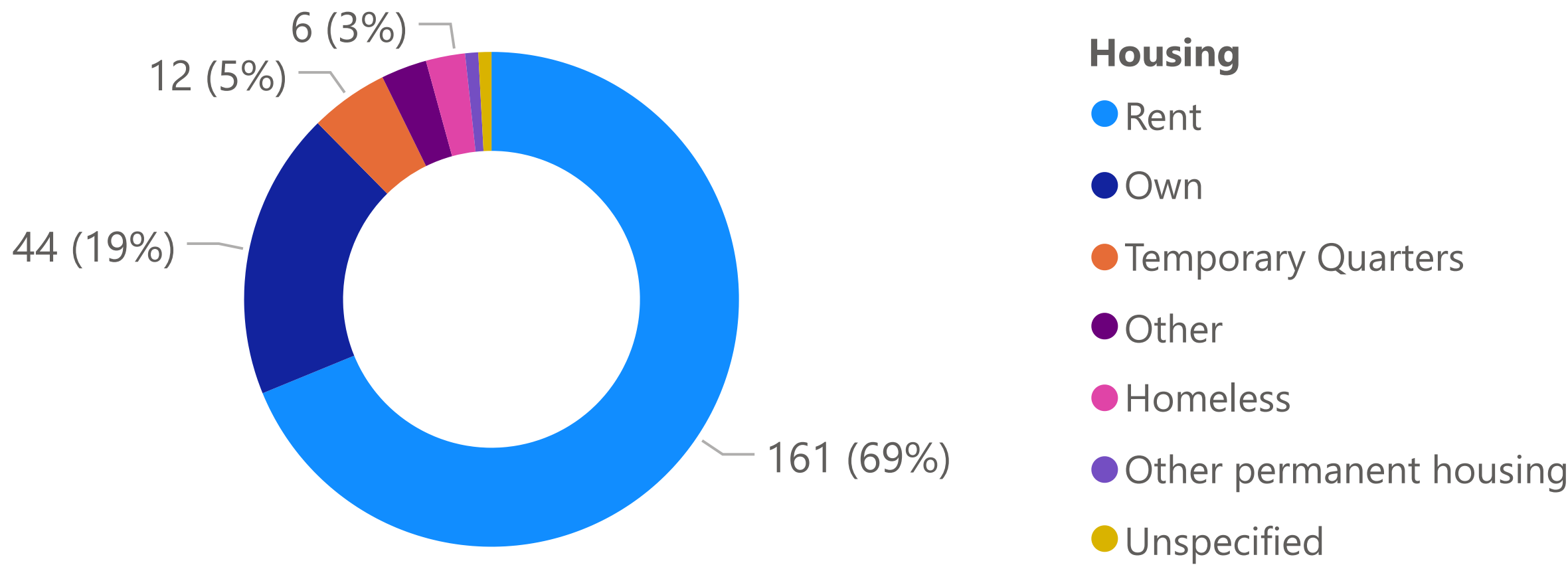

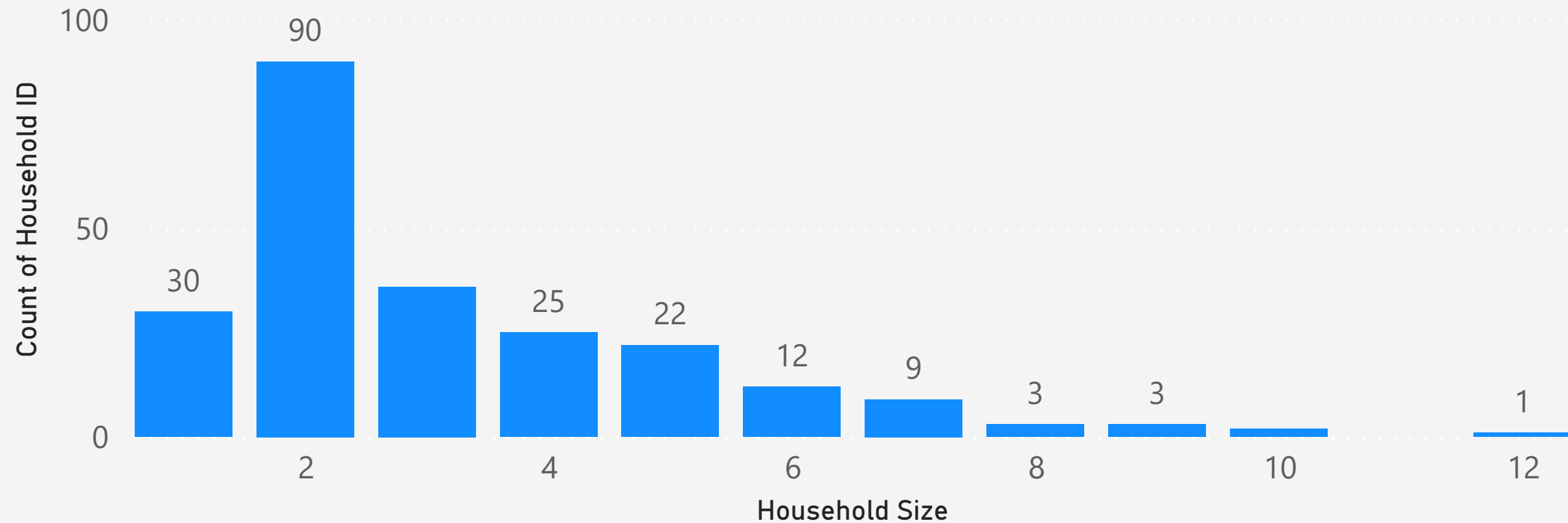

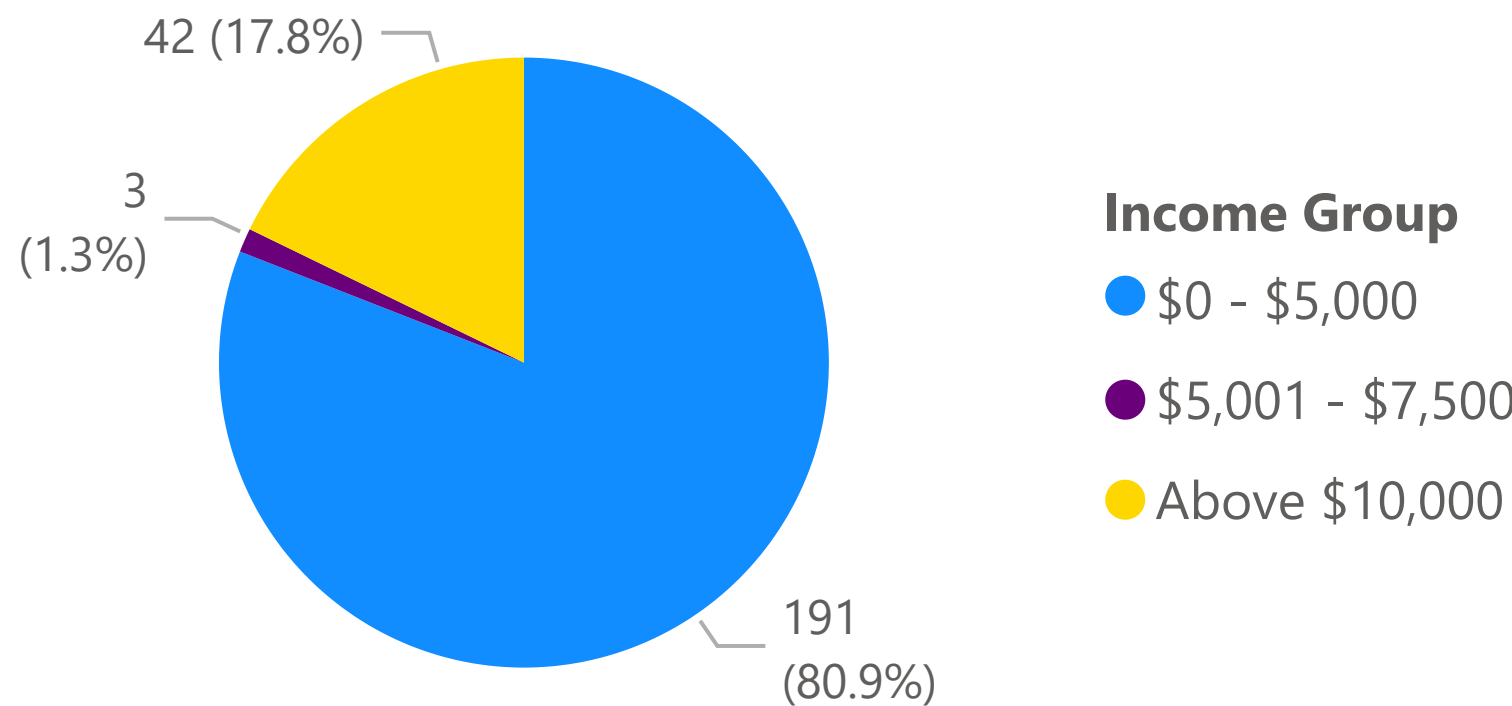

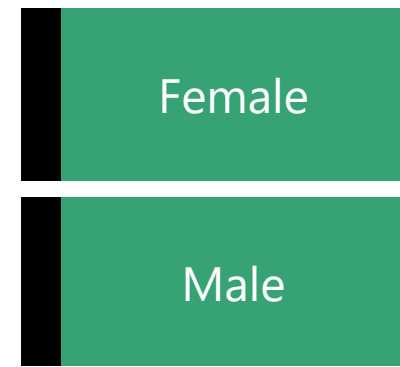

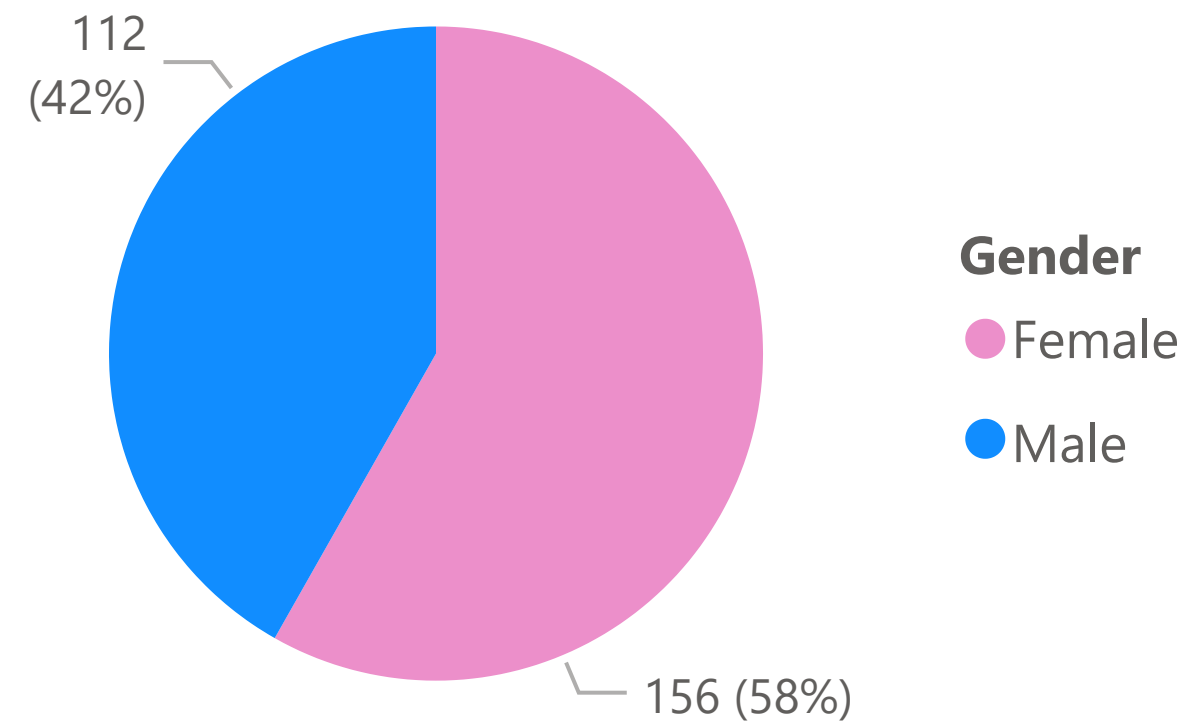

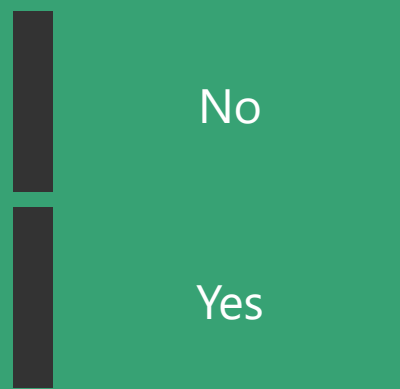

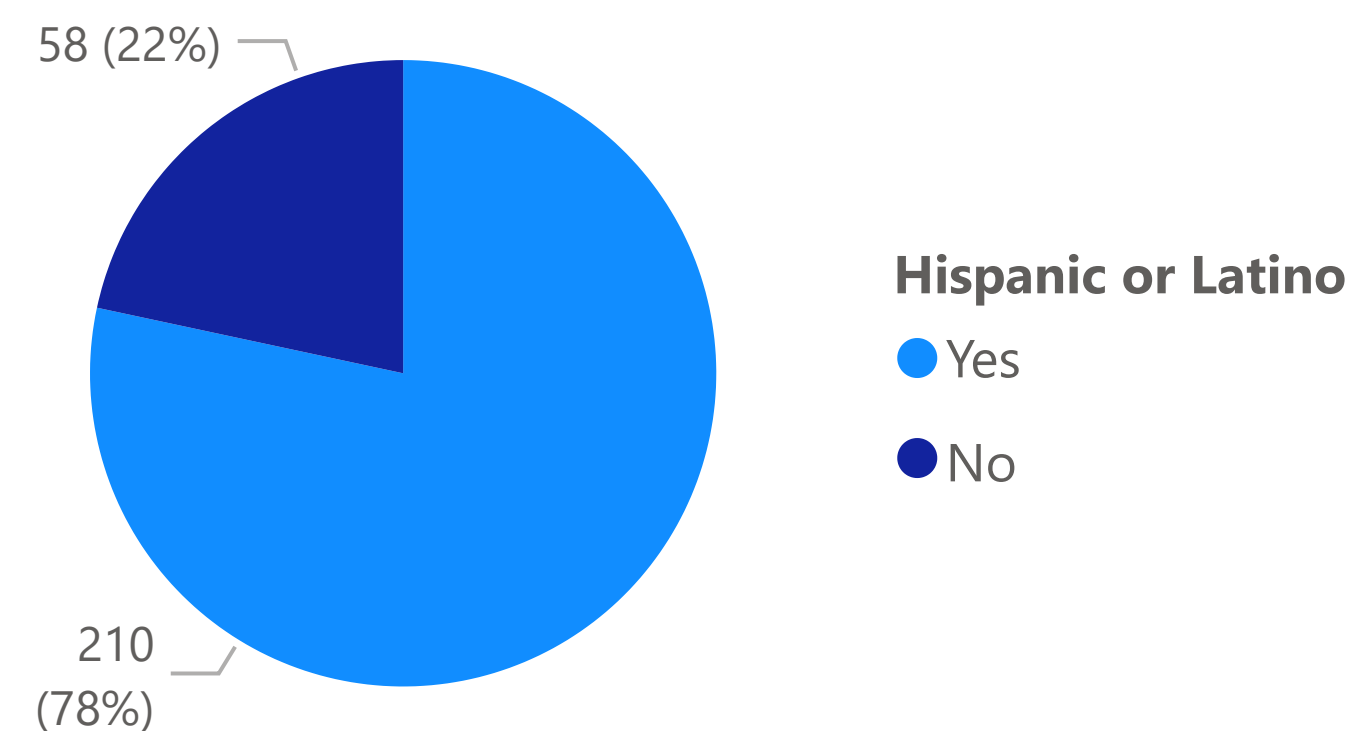
Number of Students by Gender

Number of Students by Hispanic or Latino

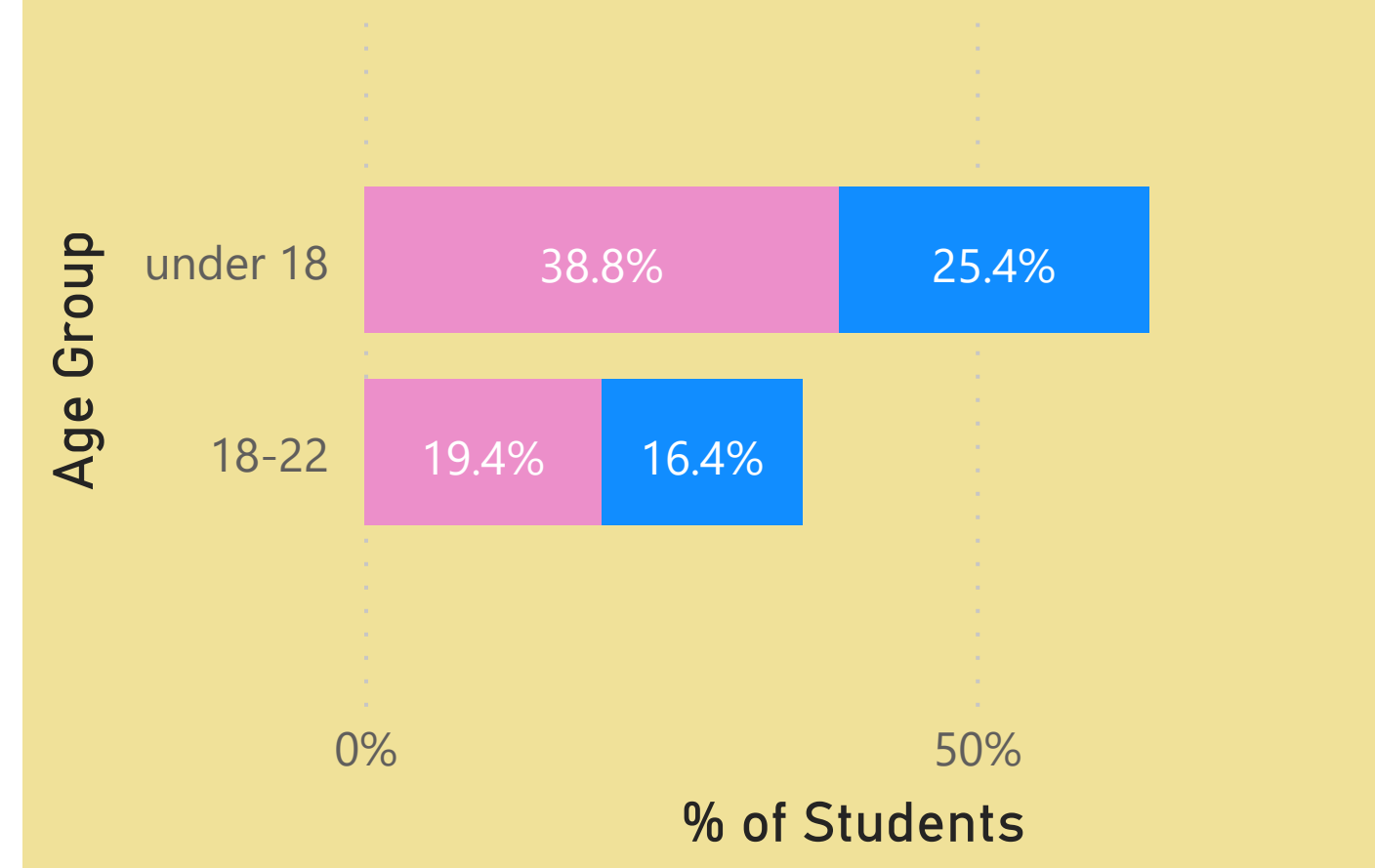

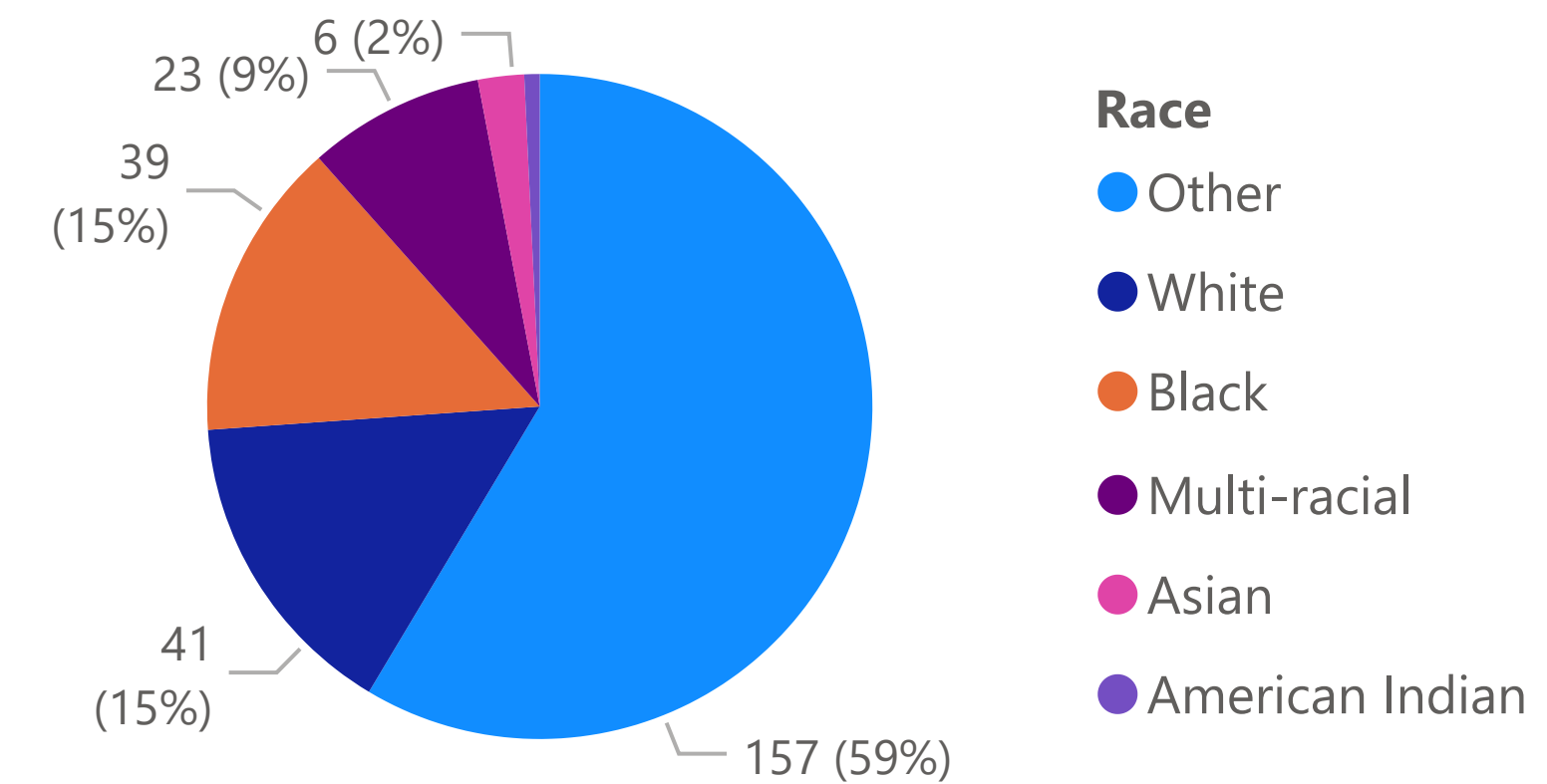

% of Students by Age Group by Gender

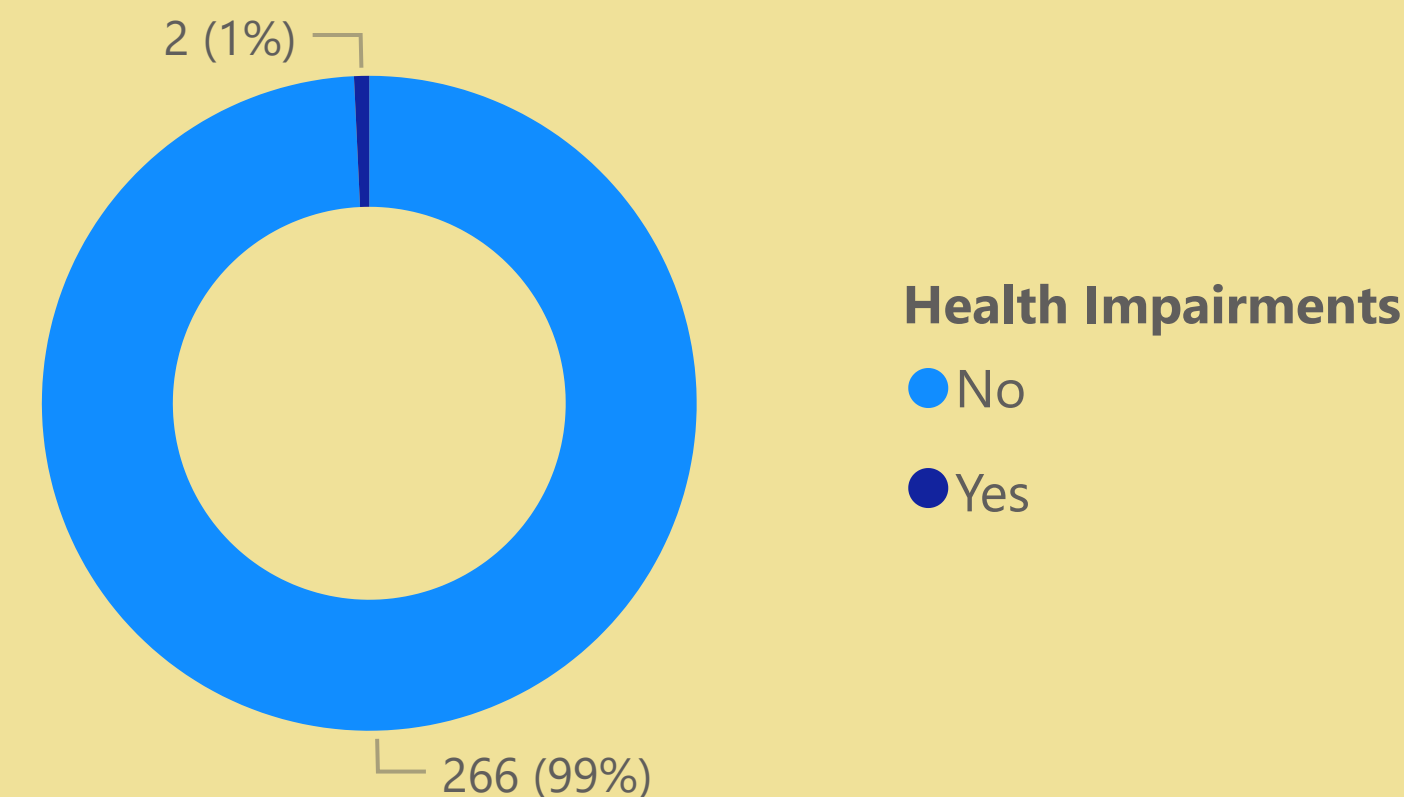

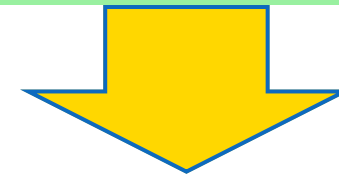

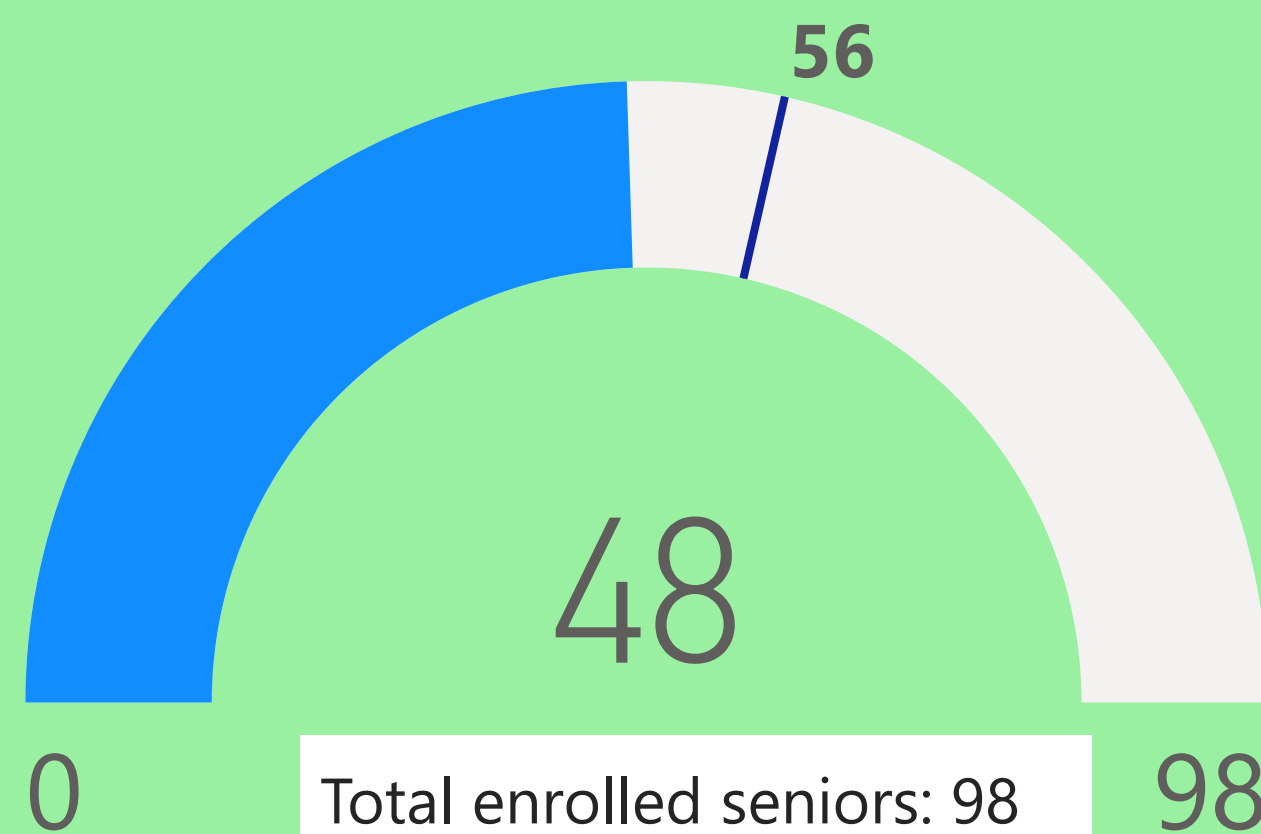

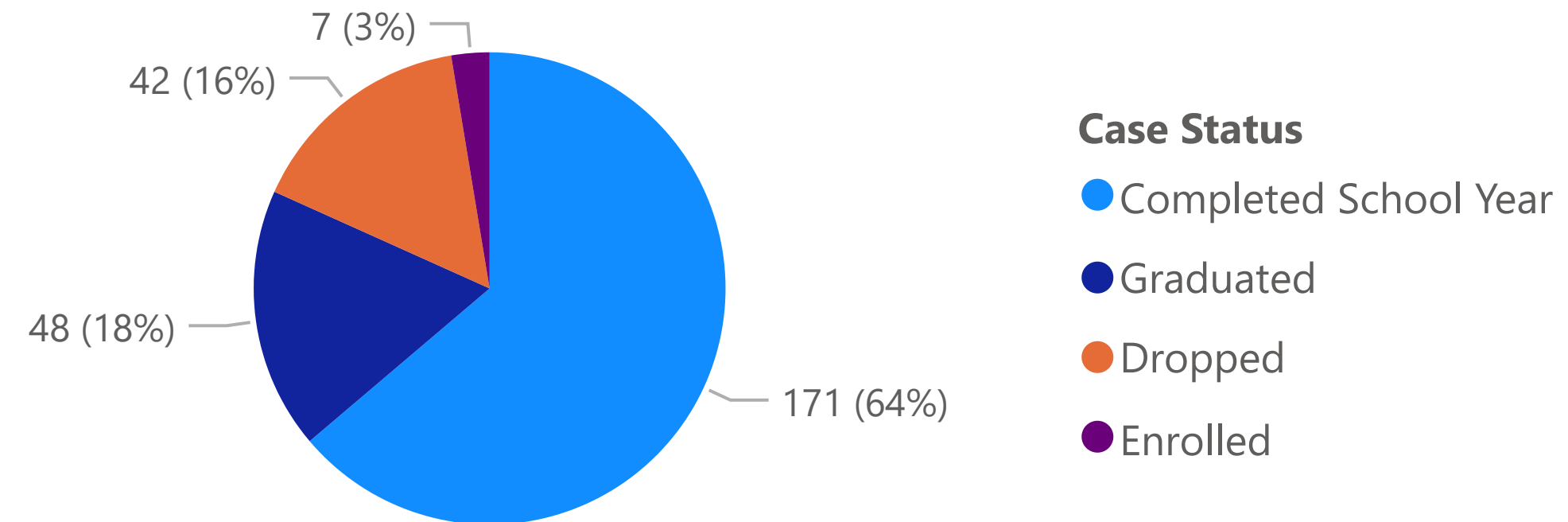
Actual Graduates: 48

Graduated VS Goal



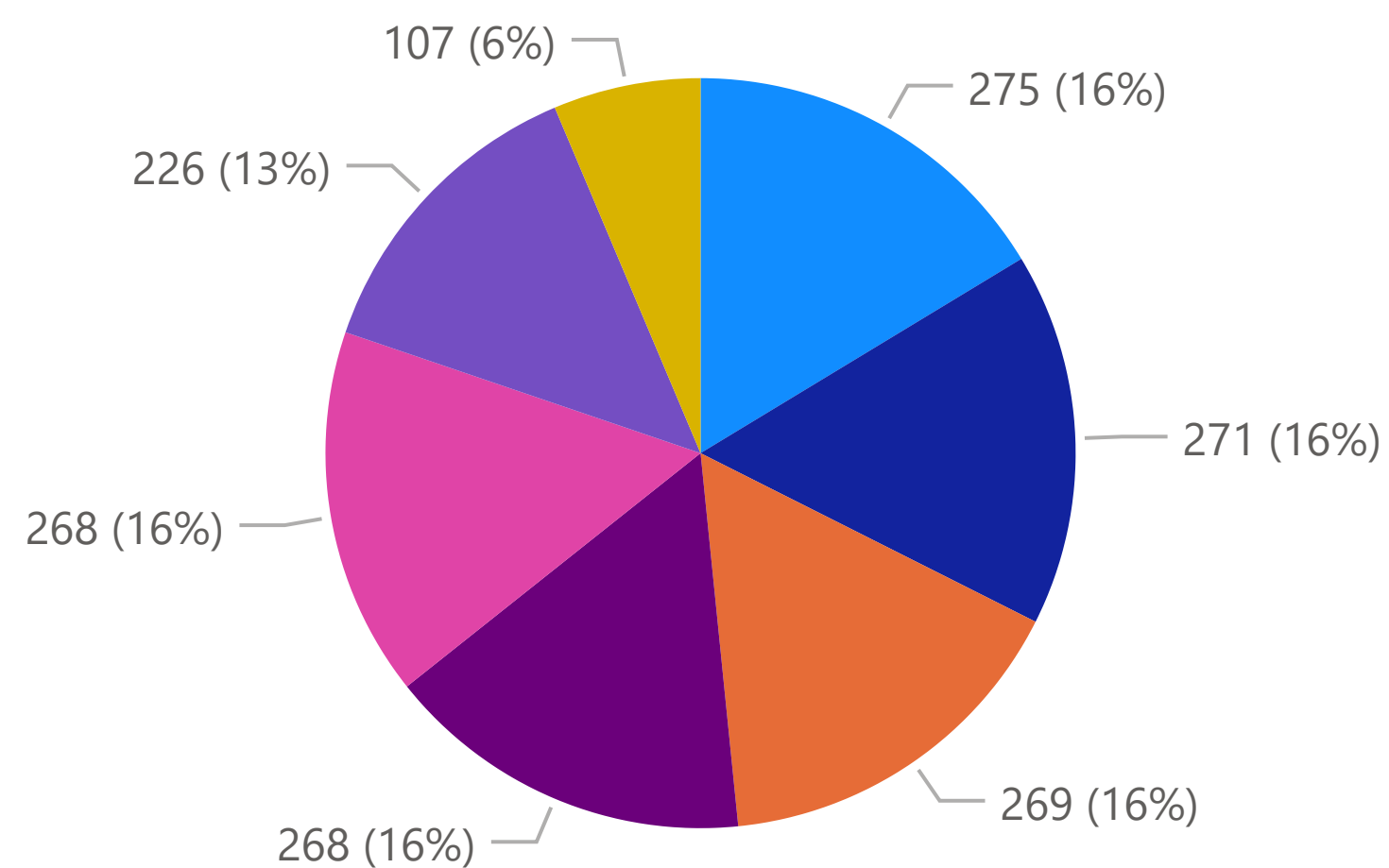
Number of Students by Case Status

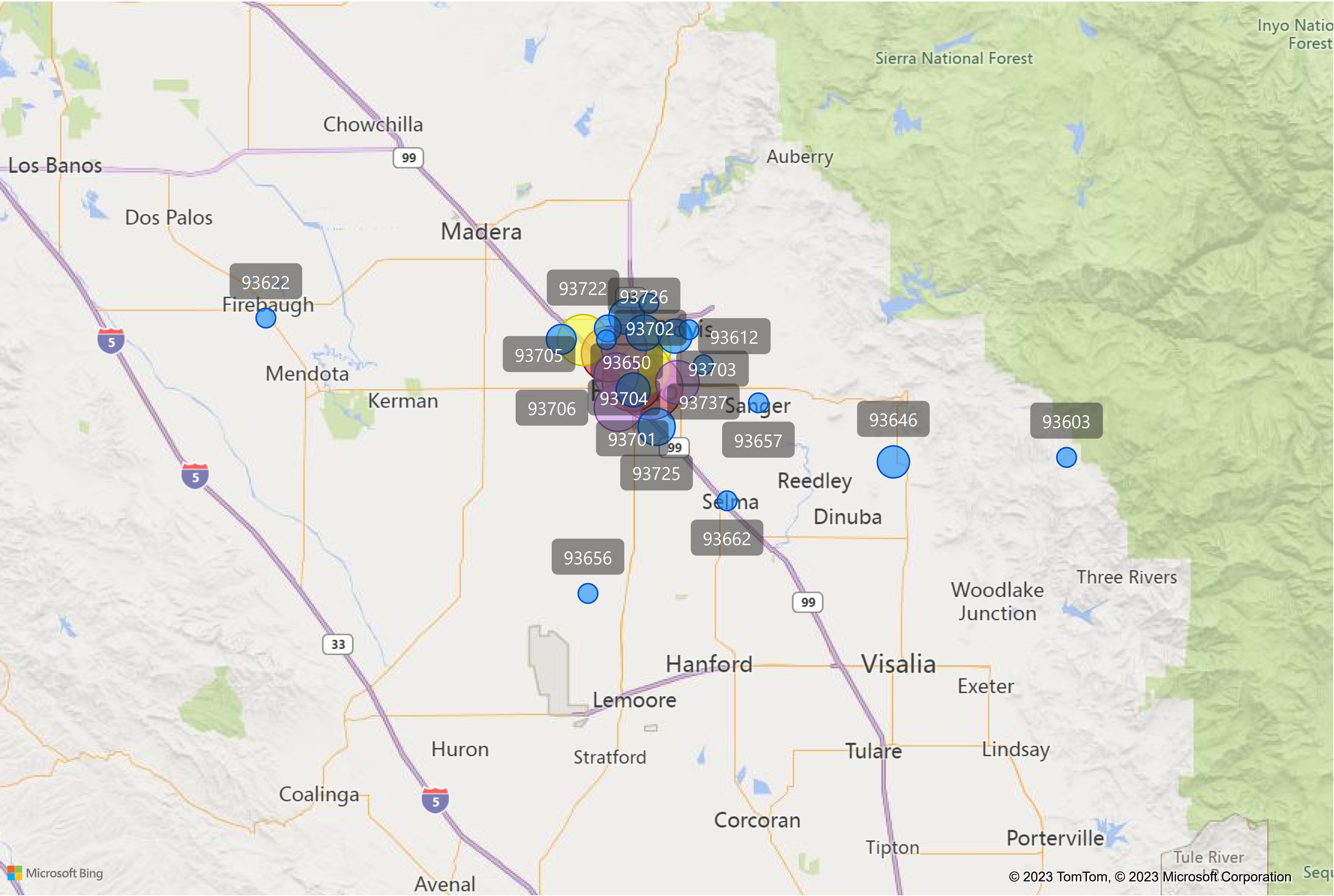

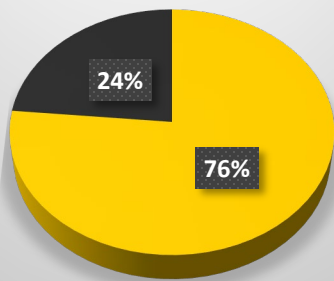

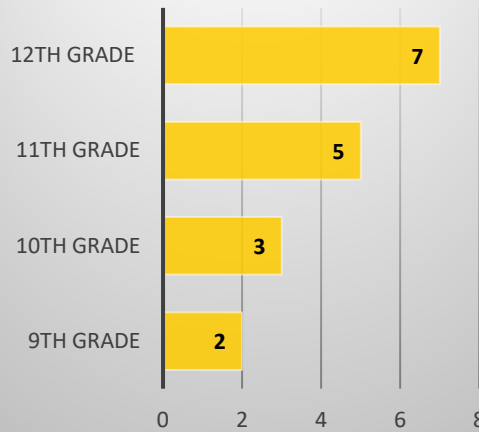

by Gender

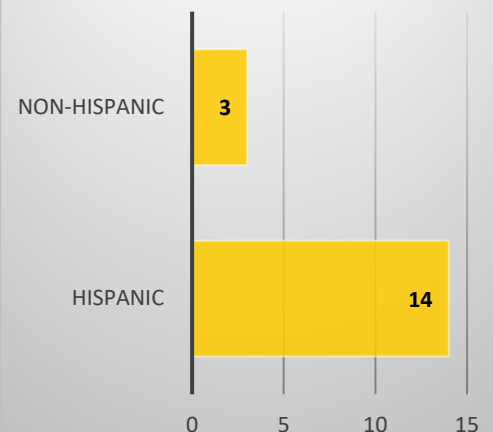

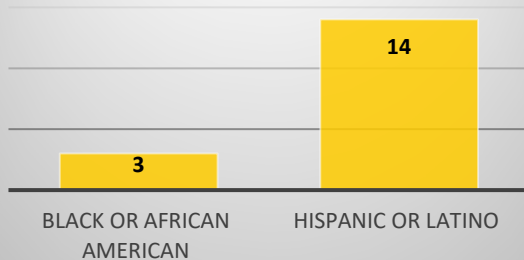
Classroom Based Students by
Grade



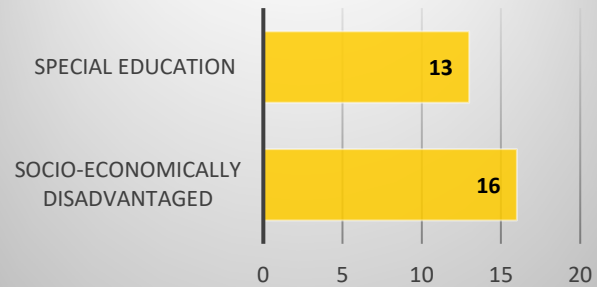
Classroom Based
Students by Ethnicity



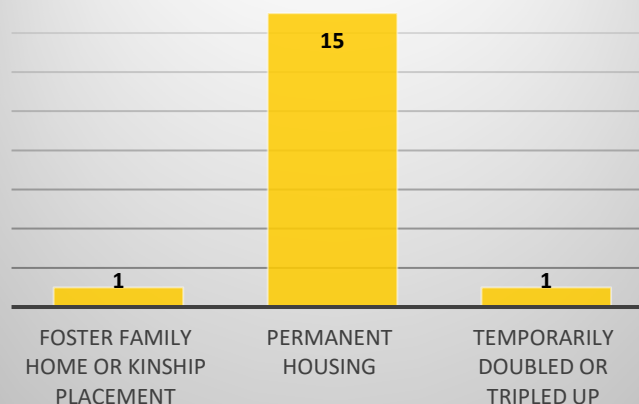
Classroom Based Students

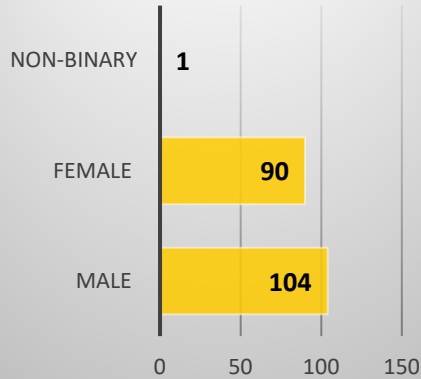

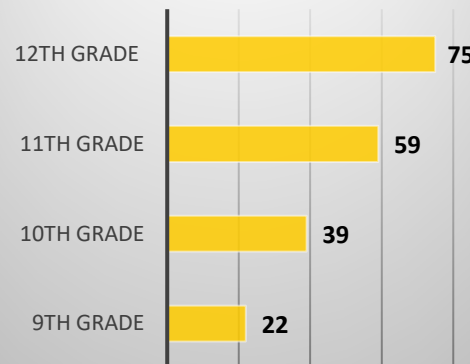

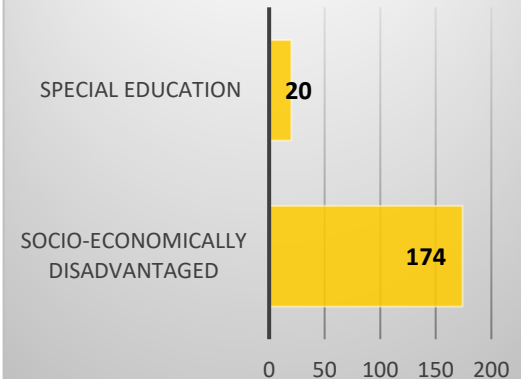
Independent Study by Gender



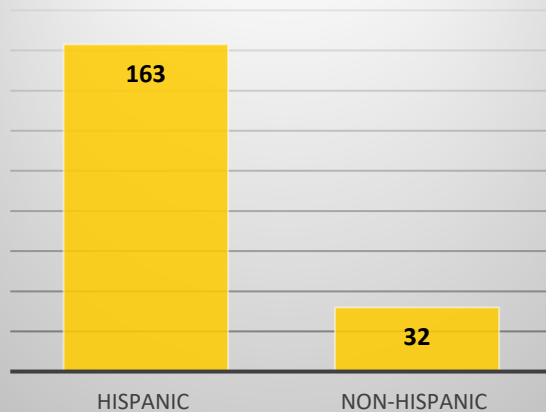
Independent Study Students by Grade



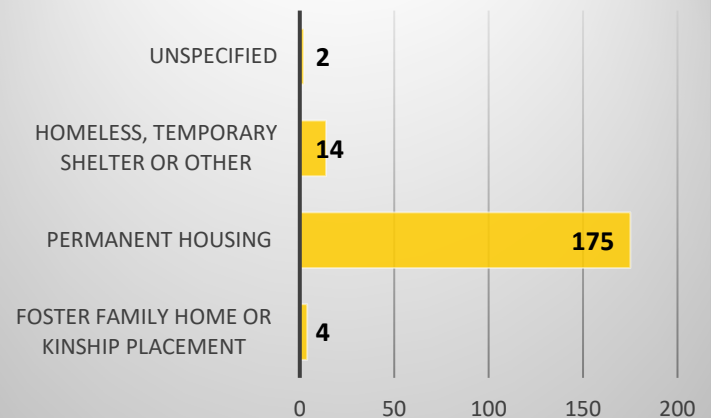
Independent Study Students by Reported Programs
