#### **Recommended Action**

Staff seeks Committee feedback of the estimated 2024 CSBG proposed budget for the State of California Department of Community Services and Development (CSD) Agreement prior to full Board Approval.

#### Background

The State of California Department of Community Services and Development (CSD) administers Community Services Block Grant (CSBG) funds allocated to states, by formula, by the federal Office of Community Services (OCS). CSBG funds are made available to Community Action Agencies to help alleviate the causes and conditions of poverty in their targeted regions.

With the approval of the agency's 2023 -2026 Strategic Plan with the updated mission and vision, the 2024 CSBG budget has been continuously strategically aligned with our focus areas and strategic goals. The intention is to provide support for the areas that our board and community have expressed the need.

#### **Fiscal Impact**

CSD has not yet released the awarded CSBG funding amount. The total expected budget amount of \$1,950,000 is estimated on prior year awards.

#### Conclusion

If approved by the Committee, staff will work with CSD for the release of the award and adjust accordingly to expend the full amount of the funding.
