Who are WIC Breastfeeding Peer Counselors?

WIC Breastfeeding Peer Counselors are from your community, have breastfed their babies, and offer support that works for you.

WIC Peer Counselors:

- Are moms just like you.
- See you at WIC for appointments or support groups.
- Talk with you by phone, video, and text.
- Offer breastfeeding support when you need it, and are often available outside WIC office hours.
- Share breastfeeding information with you.
- Have been carefully selected and trained by WIC.
- Respect your cultural, financial, and personal challenges.
- Offer encouragement that embraces your community and culture.

WIC Peer Counselors:

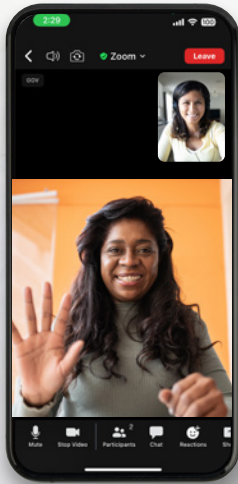
- Listen to you and encourage you.
- Give you extra support, especially during those first few weeks after birth.
- Show you ways to get a good start with breastfeeding that work for you.
- Share tips for making plenty of breastmilk for your baby.
- Answer your questions and talk through your breastfeeding concerns.
- Respect and support your feeding choices.
- Provide referrals to breastfeeding experts and community services.
- Work with you to find ways to keep breastfeeding after you return to work or school.



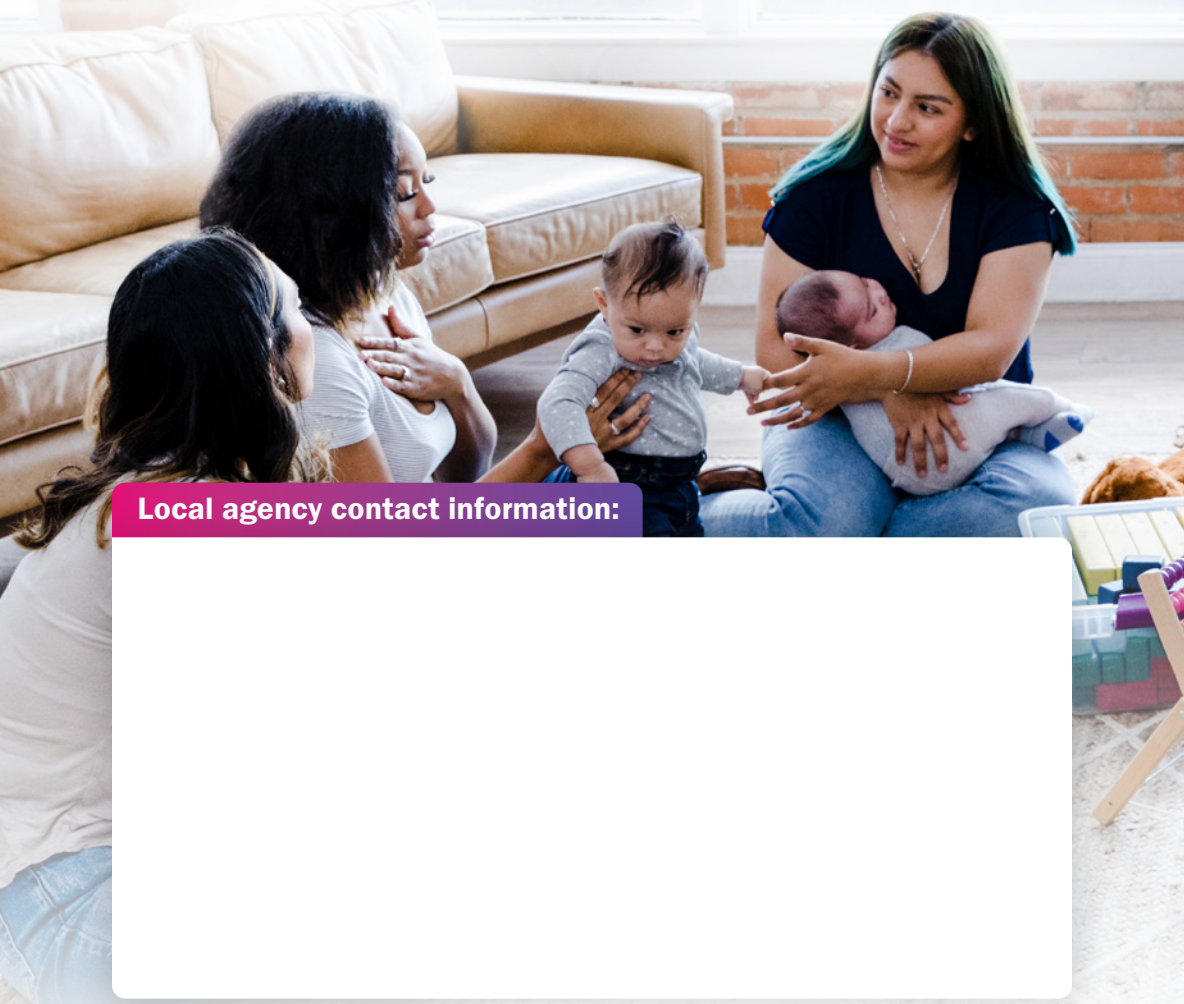


I know I can ask for help when I need it with the WIC breastfeeding program.
